Calcium score	Interpretation	Risk of myocardial infarction/stroke at 10 years
0	Very low risk	<1%
1 - 100	low risk	<10%
101 - 400	Moderate risk	10–20%
101–400 and >75th percentile	Moderately high risk	15–20%
>400	High risk	>20%
