## **Critical Care Time Chart**

This document provides a reference chart for healthcare professionals to accurately document and reference the appropriate CPT codes based on the total duration of critical care provided to a patient. Proper documentation is crucial for accurate billing and reimbursement.

## **Total Duration of Critical Care and Appropriate CPT Codes**

Total duration of critical care	Appropriate CPT codes
Less than 30 minutes	99232 or 99233 or other appropriate E/M code
30 - 74 minutes	99291
75 - 104 minutes	99291 x 1 and 99292 x 1
105 - 134 minutes	99291 x 1 and 99292 x 2
135 - 164 minutes	99291 x 1 and 99292 x 3
165 - 194 minutes	99291 x 1 and 99292 x 4
195 - 224 minutes	99291 x 1 and 99292 x 5
225 - 254 minutes	99291 x 1 and 99292 x 6
255 - 284 minutes	99291 x 1 and 99292 x 7
285 - 314 minutes	99291 x 1 and 99292 x 8
315 minutes or longer	99291 x 1 and 99292 x 9+

## **Important Notes:**

- CPT Code 99291: Used for the first 30-74 minutes of critical care on a given calendar date.
- CPT Code 99292: Used for each additional 30 minutes of critical care beyond the initial 74 minutes.
- Critical care time can be continuous or aggregated over a single date.
