Unified Parkinson's Disease Rating Scale (UPDRS)	
<i>V. Modified Hoehn and Yahr Staging</i>	
Stage 0	No signs of disease
Stage 1	Unilateral disease
Stage 1.5	Unilateral plus axial involvement
Stage 2	Bilateral disease, without impairment of balance
Stage 2.5	Mild bilateral disease, with recovery on pull test
Stage 3	Mild to moderate bilateral disease; some postural instability; physically
Stage 4	Severe disability; still able to walk or stand unassisted
Stage 5	Wheelchair bound or bedridden unless aided
