<ol> <li>Positioning of patient: Ensure the patient's arm is relaxed at their side; note any initial discomfort.</li> <li>Palpation: Begin by palpating the shoulder area to locate the supraspinatus tendon; note any initial findings such as tenderness or gaps.</li> <li>Manipulation: Instruct the patient to rotate their arm internally and externally. Carefully observe any changes in pain or detectable defects in the tendon area.</li> <li>Observations: Record any pain response, palpable gaps, or other abnormalities detected during manipulation. Look for the presence of a palpable or prominent eminence (Greater tuberosity) and/or rent (defect or 'sulcus') which indicates a full-thickness tear.</li> </ol>
