
## **Spurling's Test**

## **Test procedure**

- Seat the patient comfortably in a neutral position and stand behind the patient.
- 2. Extend the patient's neck.
- 3. Bend the patient's head laterally toward the affected side.
- 4. Apply axial compression to the top of the head.



## Results and interpretation

- Positive result: The maneuver reproduces radicular pain or other symptoms in the arm corresponding to the affected nerve root.
- Negative result: No pain or symptom is provoked or reproduced.

## **Additional notes**

Patient reported sharp pain radiating down the left arm during compression. Immediate referral to further imaging recommended.
